INFROMATION ON COUNTY OF AROOSTOOK FACILITIES

(Updated 3/20/2020)

Access to our facilities are either closed or have limited access. We ask that if you visit one of our facilities to please limit your stay to the shortest time frame possible. Please practice Social Distancing in keeping six (6) feet away from other persons. Wash your hands frequently and use hand sanitizer when soap and water are not available. We currently have hand sanitizer stations in the hallways of all of our facilities. If you are sick, please do not visit our facilities.

The Northern and Southern Registry of Deeds and Registry of Probate are open with drop off boxes to leave documents for processing. We do not have on-site interaction with the public at this time.

Administration Office, Human Recourses, Unorganized Territory Community Services, Emergency Management Agency, Sheriff's Office Building, Aroostook County Jail and District Attorneys' Offices are currently closed to the public.
